- Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their **17th** birthday before 1st January in the current year.

7. EQUIFEST SHOW PONY LEAD REIN (Class 45)

Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their **8th** birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

8. NATHAN ARNOLD SHOW TEAM / EQUIFEST SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN (Class 46)

First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their **10th** birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

9. KBIS / EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES (Class 42)

Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their **20th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their **12th** birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms.

TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes Show Number TGCA/05/18/031

Pure Bred classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all pure bred traditional gypsy cobs.

Stallions – All stallions (pure or part bred, four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook. Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members will receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook). Qualification goes to top three in each class. If the class is open height, then top three in each height section qualify.

Quest Championship Shows

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship, **provided** they are current TGCA members and the horse is TGCA registered. Membership cards and qualification cards (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

In Hand & Ridden The Championship is open to Stallions, Mares or Geldings. Stallions must be registered with the HPS and be exhibited by persons 18 years and over.

1. The Show reserves the right to amalgamate any Class with less than 3 entries or sub-divide any class.
2. Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the class being judged, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.
3. The judge's decision is FINAL. Any abuse towards judges or officials will result in immediate disqualification.
4. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident or incident to animals, persons or property.
5. The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final.
6. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies in the correct class or classes.
7. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.
8. **ENTRY FEES are NOT refundable after the close of postal entries** – even with a Doctor / Veterinary Certificate. All requests for refund must be applied for in writing.
9. No trotting or cantering will be allowed in any public area, only in the designated warm up area.
10. All horses and ponies should have 3rd party and public liability insurance.
11. No Ponies may be plaited in M & M Classes.
12. **Correctly secured British Standard skull caps/riding hats that meet the current BSI safety standards of PAS015: 1998/PAS015: 2011. VG1. ASTM F1163 04a. SNELL E2001. AS/NZ 3838 2003 onwards or latest standard must be worn at all times when mounted.**
13. All children 14 years and under must wear HARD HATS when showing in-hand.
14. No loose dogs allowed on the showground/arenas.
15. Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".
16. Children must be three years old before competing in any ridden class.
17. All ponies entered in M & M classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and with entries on the day.
18. No Litter to be left anywhere and mucking out of horseboxes/trailers in the lorry park is strictly forbidden.
19. No behaviour of an offensive, abusive or unpleasant manner to any person at The East Anglia Horse Show will be tolerated. Any act of discourtesy to any Judge, Steward or any Show Official on the part of the competitor groom, rider, driver or agent of an animal, will, at the discretion of such Official disqualify that animal from being judged, in which case entry fees, prizes and charges will be forfeited. Exhibitors are reminded of their responsibility for the actions of others within their party.

20. No person shall ill-treat animals at any time whether by misuse/excessive use of a whip, bit or any item of saddlery or in any other way whatsoever.

21. **STALLIONS – in the interest of safety, stallions may only be ridden / driven / handled by** persons over the age of 14 years – with the exception of Small Breeds Mountain & Moorland stallions, where the rider / handler must have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January in the current year. Stallions are not permitted in any Young Handler, Equitation, Junior Ridden M&M, Lead Rein or First Ridden classes. Drivers of stallions must have an active, responsible adult with them at all times

22. A fall of animal or rider whilst mounted in any class will result in disqualification and they **MUST** leave the ring **DIS-MOUNTED**. If an animal

gets loose from its handler whilst in the ring it will also result in disqualification.

23. No competitor shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant manner to any show official or judge at any show or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format, If a competitor is found to be doing so, they will not be allowed to enter any more TEAHS shows for the remainder of the season, if the competitor continues this behavior the ban will continue throughout the following season. TEAHS takes this behavior very seriously.
