6. In Hand Cobs Traditional/Hogged Horse/Pony - Open to Horses/Ponies any age. Traditional Cobs to be shown in an untrimmed state with feathers and Show Cobs to be shown hogged and trimmed - **TEAHS, ESUK, RL**

7. Native Home Produced In Hand - Ponies which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January in the current year have not been shown by a producer or stabled in a producer's yard other than on a DIY basis or at stud. Ponies shown in these classes must be produced and shown by the owner/spouse or his/her Immediate Family. *Connermara, Dales, Dartmoor, Eriskay, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh.* **TEAHS**

10. The NPS/ EQUESTRIAN MARKETPLACE M&M In Hand Yearlings, 2 and 3 year ponies.

The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the qualification. Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or the qualification.

not to exceed 148 cms at maturity, registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB; the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland stud books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

13. The NPS/MENEDH STUD Show Hunter Pony In Hand National Championship Youngstock, stallions, mares and geldings not to exceed 153 cms at maturity, registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB; the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland stud books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

14. NPS /CASES SHEET METAL FABRICATIONS OTTERGAYLE Hack & Riding Horse In Hand Supreme Championship Youngstock, stallions, mares and geldings, no specific registration criteria. Open to registered mares and geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122 cm. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. *NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship Qualifier – wear white arm bands*

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern August 2019. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB. Ponies must be plaited. Classes open to stallions mares and geldings 4 years old and over.

8. **ENTRY FEES are NOT refundable after the close of postal entries – even with a Doctor / Veterinary Certificate.** All requests for refund must be applied for in writing.
9. No trotting or cantering will be allowed in any public area, only in the designated warm up area.
10. All horses and ponies should have 3rd party and public liability insurance.
11. No Ponies may be plaited in M & M Classes.
12. **Correctly secured British Standard skull caps/riding hats that meet the current BSI safety standards of PAS015: 1998/PAS015: 2011. VG1. ASTM F1163 04a. SNELL E2001. AS/NZ 3838 2003 onwards or latest standard must be worn at all times when mounted.**
13. All children 14 years and under must wear HARD HATS when showing in-hand.
14. No loose dogs allowed on the showground/arenas.
15. Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".
16. Children must be three years old before competing in any ridden class.
17. All ponies entered in M & M classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and with entries on the day.
18. No Litter to be left anywhere and mucking out of horseboxes/trailers in the lorry park is strictly forbidden.

19. No behaviour of an offensive, abusive or unpleasant manner to any person at The East Anglia Horse Show will be tolerated. Any act of discourtesy to any Judge, Steward or any Show Official on the part of the competitor groom, rider, driver or agent of an animal, will, at the discretion of such Official disqualify that animal from being judged, in which case entry fees, prizes and charges will be forfeited. Exhibitors are reminded of their responsibility for the actions of others within their party.

20. No person shall ill-treat **ANIMALS** or **CHILDREN** at any time whether by misuse/excessive use of a whip, bit or any item of saddlery or in any other way whatsoever.

21. **STALLIONS** – in the interest of safety, stallions may only be ridden / driven / handled by persons over the age of 14 years – with the exception of Small Breeds Mountain & Moorland stallions, where the rider / handler must have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January in the current year. Stallions are not permitted in any Young Handler, Equitation, Junior Ridden M&M, Lead Rein or First Ridden classes. Drivers of stallions must have an active, responsible adult with them at all times

22. A fall of animal or rider whilst mounted in any class will result in disqualification and they **MUST** leave the ring **DIS-MOUNTED**. If an animal gets loose from it's handler whilst in the ring it will also result in disqualification.

23. **No competitor shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant manner to any show official or judge at any show or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format, If a competitor is found to be doing so, they will not be allowed to enter any more TEAHS shows for the remainder of the season, if the competitor continues this behavior the ban will continue throughout the following season. TEAHS takes this behavior very seriously.**
